Clinic Rules: Pitbull / Pitbull mix and aggressive dogs must be muzzled. Please do not bring your pet to the rabies clinic on a retractable leash. Every dog should be on a non-retractable leash and properly restrained while at the clinic. All pets must be held by a person 18 years or older. Because our rabies clinics are often held in an outdoor setting, vaccinating cats can be difficult. To decrease the chance that your cat will escape, please do not bring cats in a cardboard box or pet adoption box. Cats must be in a Vari-kennel or similar pet carrier. Please be aware that cats will be vaccinated in the scruff of the neck. Your pet will only get a 3 year rabies vaccine if you can show written proof that (1) the last rabies vaccine was given 9-12 months prior to clinic date (2) or that your pet has had a 3 year rabies vaccine at any point in the past.
