### BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Section 2 of Chapter 42 of the Massachusetts General Laws requires towns to locate the boundaries markers once every five years. On February 10, 1896, the Board of Aldermen appointed three members of the Board, Aldermen Lee, Bryant and Barry, together with the City Clerk and City Engineer to the committee to perambulate the boundary lines and to examine the bound marks between Boston and the adjoining towns and cities of Everett, Revere, Somerville, Newton, Brookline, Dedham, and Hyde Park. The Committee met with the representatives of the adjoining towns in late May and early June to perambulate the boundary lines. The final report was submitted to the Board of Aldermen on June 15, 1896. As part of the report, each boundary marker was photographed and bound in a volume along with maps documenting the location.
