** Additionally, while Sterling Suffolk Racecourse, LLC does not believe that the following is a contribution, political contribution or contribution in kind, but rather it is a reimbursement of actual third party costs incurred in the review of the Applicant's project impacts and in negotiating a host community agreement, we note that on or about August 21, 2012, Sterling Suffolk Racecourse, LLC provided \$135,000.00 in funds to the City of Revere under a Reimbursement Agreement entered into as of August 21, 2012. The purpose of the Reimbursement Agreement is to cover costs associated with the evaluation of impacts and the negotiation of a host community agreement and, as further costs are incurred by the City of Revere, other payments may be made by the Applicant under that agreement.
