1. On a petition of 333 Washington Street Condo Trust, & Jay Shoostine for a **License and Installation of a Pedestal Clock** at 333 Washington Street, Boston Proper: **(N.B. 11/18/2010)**

As shown on plans entitled City of Boston Public Works Department Engineering Division, **Specific Repair Plan – 333 Washington Street, Boston Proper – 3 Sheets, dated November 16, 2010**

2. On a petition of the Trustees of Boston University for installation of an **Earth Retention System** in the following street in Boston Proper: **(N.B. 11/18/2010)**

- Deerfield Street on its southwesterly side from a point approximately 16 feet southeast of Bay State Road approximately 125 feet in a southeasterly direction

As shown on a plan entitled City of Boston Public Works Department Engineering Division, **Temporary Earth Retention Plan – Deerfield Street, Boston Proper – 1 Sheet, dated October 1, 2010**

3. On a petition of the Trustees of Boston University for the making of **Specific Repairs** in the following streets in Boston Proper: **(N.B. 11/18/2010)**

- Deerfield Street on its southwesterly side from Commonwealth Avenue to Bay State Road consisting of the installation of a new sidewalk cement concrete and granite pavers with a wire cut brick accent strip, trees and tree pits with cobbles, a drip irrigation /aeration system, street lights, and three driveway openings.
- Bay State Road on its southerly side from Deerfield Street consisting of the installation of a new cement concrete sidewalk, trees and tree pits, a drip irrigation /aeration system, street lights, and a pedestrian ramp with tactile domes
