PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, the BOSTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION will hold a public hearing in Boston City Hall, Room 801 on January 19, 2011 to review the following projects to determine what conditions, if any, the Commission will impose in order to protect the interests of the public and private water supply, ground water, prevention of pollution, flood control, prevention of storm damage, protection of fisheries and land containing shellfish, and protection of wildlife habitat:

6:00 PM Notice of Intent from CSREFI Independence Wharf Boston Inc., for the installation of a pile supported timber float dock, aluminum ramp and fixed platform, at 470 Atlantic Avenue, Boston, Fort Point Channel (Land Under Ocean).

6:15 PM Notice of Intent from the Boston Parks and Recreation Department for the repair and rehabilitation of an existing granite block seawall at Ryan Playground, 51 Alford Street, Charlestown, Mystic River (Coastal Bank, 100-foot Buffer Zone).

Request for Certificate of Compliance for Order of Conditions **DEP File No. 006-0764** from Union Wharf Condominium Trust for seawall and dock maintenance, at 343 Commercial Street, North End, Boston Inner Harbor.
