PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, the BOSTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION will hold a public hearing in Boston City Hall, Room 801 on October 20, 2010 to review the following projects to determine what conditions, if any, the Commission will impose in order to protect the interests of the public and private water supply, ground water, prevention of pollution, flood control, prevention of storm damage, protection of fisheries and land containing shellfish, and protection of wildlife habitat:

6:00 PM Request for Determination of Applicability from the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation for repairs to the John W. Weeks Footbridge, including the restoration of deteriorated limestone balustrades and deck joints, and replacement of navigational lights, Brighton, Charles River (100-foot Buffer Zone to Inland Bank).

6:15 PM Request from the Boston Parks and Recreation Department for improvements to the Barry Playground, including construction of a new ball field and appurtenant structures, site grading, cleaning of an existing stormwater management system, installation of an irrigation system, and construction of a skate park and Harborwalk, Medford Street, Charlestown, Little Mystic Channel (Coastal Bank, 100-foot Buffer Zone).

6:30 PM Request for Determination of Applicability from Brushill Partners, LLC, as to whether work associated with the development of a single family home, and the project site, are subject to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, 80 Crosstown Avenue, West Roxbury.

6:45 PM Report from the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation on the annual seasonal cuttings of vegetation, pursuant to the Order of Conditions **DEP File No. 006-0971**, for the Charles River Basin Shoreline Vegetation Management Plan, Charles River, Boston (Riverfront Area, Inland Bank, 100-foot Buffer Zone).
