## ZONING HEARING

The Zoning Commission of the City of Boston hereby gives notice, in accordance with Chapter 665 of the Acts of 1956, as amended, that a public hearing will be held on July 23, 2014, at 9:30 AM, in Room 900, Ninth Floor, Boston City Hall, in connection with Text Amendment Application No. 439 and Map Amendment Application No. 628 filed by the Boston Redevelopment Authority.

Said text application would amend Article 51, Allston-Brighton Neighborhood District, specifically Section 51-44 (Establishment of Areas Within Which Planned Development Areas May Be Permitted), Section 51-45.2 (Dimensional Regulations) and Table E (Allston-Brighton Neighborhood District, Neighborhood Business Subdistricts, Dimensional Regulations(1)), by inserting the Cleveland Circle Community Commercial Subdistrict as an area where Planned Development Areas ("PDAs") may be permitted as well as making minor amendments to said Sections. Said map application would change the existing zoning designation of land located in the Cleveland Circle section of Brighton from "NS-1", indicating a Neighborhood Shopping Subdistrict to "CC-3", indicating a Community Commercial Subdistrict as well as making the land "PDA Permitted."
