Public Hearing

1. On a petition by the neighborhood abutters for a **Square Dedication** concerning the intersection of **Dudley Street, East Cottage Street, and West Cottage Street** in Dorchester, to recognize Sr. Margaret Leonard. (NB 9/4/2014)
2. On a petition by Lighttower Fiber Networks for a **Grant of Location** with lead company status and no participants to install telecommunication conduit within **Northampton Street**, Boston Proper, located generally northwest of Reed Street. (NB 9/4/2014)

As shown on a plan entitled Proposed Plan, Northampton St at Reed St, Boston, MA, Lighttower Fiber Networks, 1 sheet dated May, 2014.

3. On a petition by MP Franklin Burnham Co LLC for the making of **Specific Repairs** within **Washington Street**, Boston Proper, located on its southeasterly side generally northeast of Summer Street, and consisting of reconstructed and relocated cement concrete sidewalks, specialty pavement, and street furniture. (NB 9/4/2014)

As shown on a plan entitled City of Boston Public Works Department, Engineering Division, Specific Repair, 10 Summer Street, Washington Street, Boston Proper, 1 sheet dated July, 2014.

4. On a petition by MP Franklin Tower Co LLC for the making of **Specific Repairs** within **Washington Street**, Boston Proper, located on its southeasterly side generally southwest of Franklin Street, and consisting of reconstructed and relocated cement concrete sidewalks, specialty pavement, pedestrian ramps, and street furniture. (NB 9/4/2014)

As shown on a plan entitled City of Boston Public Works Department, Engineering Division, Specific Repair, One Franklin Street, Washington Street, Boston Proper, 1 sheet dated July, 2014.

5. On a petition by MP Franklin Tower Co LLC for the granting of a **Projection License** for the installation of canopies over portions of the sidewalk within the following public ways in Boston Proper: (NB 9/4/2014)

- **Franklin Street** – on its southwesterly side between Washington Street and Hawley Street.
- **Washington Street** – on its southeasterly side generally southwest of Franklin Street.
- **Hawley Street** – on its northwesterly side generally southwest of Franklin Street.

As shown on a set of plans entitled City of Boston Public Works Department, Engineering Division, Canopy License, One Franklin Street, Washington Street, Hawley Street, Boston Proper, 2 sheets dated July, 2014.

6. On a petition by the Milk Street Café for the granting of a **Projection License** for the installation of a canopy and blade sign over portions of the sidewalk within **Milk Street**, Boston Proper, located on its northerly side generally between Devonshire Street and Arch Street. (NB 9/4/2014)

7. On a joint petition by Pier 4 Associates 2 LLC and Pier 4 Associates 3 LLC for the **Layout Approval** of **Pier 4 Place** (private way open to public travel), South Boston, to extend from the southeasterly terminus of Harbor Shore Drive to a point on Northern Avenue located approximately 250 feet southwesterly. (NB 9/4/2014)

8. On a set of joint petitions by THC/UDR Seaport Development Venture LLC and Pier 4 Associates 2 LLC for the making of **Specific Repairs** within the following public ways in South Boston, consisting of granite curb realignment, roadway, sidewalk, and pedestrian ramp reconstruction, as well as new and relocated specialty pavement, street lights, street trees, street furniture, landscaping, and irrigation infrastructure: (NB 9/4/2014)

- **Seaport Boulevard** – on its northeasterly side generally southeast of Northern Avenue.
- **Northern Avenue** – on its southeasterly side generally northeast of Seaport Boulevard.
