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COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

September 14, 2011

The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways & Means will hold a public hearing on **Monday, September 19, 2011 at 10:00AM** in the **Christopher A. Iannella Chamber**.

The subject of the hearing is:

- Docket #1224 - Message and order approving an appropriation of \$10,250,245 to fund costs related to the repair and replacement of roofs and/or boiler systems at five school facilities which have been approved by the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) under the Green Repair Program.
- Docket #1226 - Message and order authorizing the Commissioners of Police, EMS and Fire Departments to accept and expend a capital grant of \$1,056,115 from the Massachusetts Statewide Emergency Telecommunications Board, for the purpose of assisting in the establishment of an enhanced 9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP).
- Docket #1230 - Message and order authorizing the Public Works Department to accept and expend a grant of \$132,294.12 from the Boston Water and Sewer Commission, as a dispute-settlement with regard to the Franklin Hill Revitalization Capital Project.
- Docket #1231 - Message and order authorizing the Commissioners of the Public Works Department and Police Department to accept and expend capital grants of \$117,226.85 from the Massachusetts Department of Revenue, for the purpose of assisting in the removal and replacement of underground fuel storage tanks.
- Docket #1232 - Message and order authorizing the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation Department to accept and expend a capital grant of \$100,000 through the Massachusetts Attorney General, for the purpose of funding supplemental environmental project with respect to an asbestos remediation capital project at the East Boston Memorial Stadium.
- Docket #1233 - Message and order approving an appropriation of \$100,000 from the Cemetery Trust Fund, for the purpose of providing new grave space at Mt. Hope Cemetery.
- Docket #1234 - Message and order authorizing the Commissioner of the Parks and Recreation Department to accept and expend a capital grant of \$39,864 from Kemper Insurance Company, as a settlement of claims per performance bond associated with the project's original contractor in connection with the Forzio Park project in East Boston.
- Docket #1235 - Message and order authorizing the Department of Neighborhood Development to accept and expend a capital grant of \$6,329.02 from the Trinity Terrace Limited Partnership, for the purpose of partially funding the installation of "acorn lights" at Trinity Terrace Housing Development.
- Docket #1236 - Message and order authorizing the Commissioner of the Parks and Recreation Department to accept and expend a capital grant of \$5,604.83 from CBJ Consulting Incorporated, for the reimbursement of an additional unit heater installed at the George Wright Gold Course Maintenance Building as part of a capital improvement to the facility.
- Docket # 1237 - Message and order authorizing the City to appropriate the proceeds which remain unexpended following the completion of the work or purpose for which bonds, note or other obligations were originally issued, to pay the principal, premium or interest on such bonds, notes or other obligations or on any other debts of the city.
