PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, the BOSTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION will hold a public hearing in Boston City Hall, Room 801 on October 5, 2011 to review the following projects to determine what conditions, if any, the Commission will impose in order to protect the interests of the public and private water supply, ground water, prevention of pollution, flood control, prevention of storm damage, protection of fisheries and land containing shellfish, and protection of wildlife habitat:

6:00 PM Notice of Intent from the City of Boston Public Facilities Department for the construction of a public library building, parking lot and driveways, pedestrian walkways, a stormwater infrastructure system, and installation of utilities and landscaping, at 365 Bremen Street, East Boston (Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage).

6:15 PM *Updates and General Business:*

Update from the Massachusetts Port Authority on the Green Bus Depot Project, Order of Conditions DEP File No. 006-1260, and ongoing meetings with City agencies and community groups on greenway connection alternatives.

Request for Certificate of Compliance for Order of Conditions DEP File No. 006-1271 from the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation for the installation of a temporary float dock at Georges Island involving the demolition of portions of existing timber piers, removal of timber pile clusters, construction of a new timber deck and installation of steel mooring piles, Boston Harbor.
