Public Hearing

1. On a petition of the Massachusetts Port Authority for the making of **Specific Repairs** in the following streets in East Boston, consisting of realigned granite curbstones and new cement concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, street lights, catchbasins, and landscaping: **(N.B. 10/4/2012)**

- **Maverick Street** – on its northeasterly side generally 200 feet southeasterly of Jeffries Street.
- **Porter Street** – on its northeasterly side generally 200 feet southeasterly of Cottage Street.

- **Dwight Street** – vertically above the street between elevations of 28.1 feet and 29.5 feet BCB.
- **Public Alley #705** – vertically above the street between elevations of 28.1 feet and 65.8 feet BCB.
