On March 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of 2011, two Discovery Meetings were held; one in the City of Boston and the other in the City of Revere, to introduce the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA's) Risk Mapping, Assessment, and Planning (Risk MAP) Program. During these meetings, we stated that FEMA and our mapping contractor, STARR, would return to discuss the new coastal flood hazard analysis results and preliminary flood hazard mapping once work maps had been developed.
