Upon its receipt, Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.

- 14.201 SE: 49-55 Berkeley Street/9 Appleton Street: Replace non-historic entry doors to lower level lobby.
- 14.162 SE: 21 Braddock Park: In-kind replacement of rotted wood trim at mansard; replace flashing; repaint.
- 14.198 SE: 19 Bradford Street: Repair existing front entry doors and reinstall.

- 14.205 SE: 135 Warren Avenue: In-kind replacement of rotted wood trim; replace 5 windows; repaint brownstone sills and lintels.

- 14.192 SE: 20 Wellington Street: Construct a roof deck (**visibility must be reviewed by staff**).
- 14.189 SE: 149 West Concord Street: Masonry repointing; restore/repair brownstone sills and lintels.
- 14.212 SE: 31 Worcester Square: Repoint masonry; restore brownstone base, trim, all iron ornament, and wood cornice; construct a new stoop at entry (to match details at 33 Worcester Square); repair and restore wood windows; replace storm windows; construct a roof deck (**visibility must be reviewed by staff**).
- 14.191 SE: 6 Yarmouth Street: Replace asphalt shingles at mansard; in-kind replacement of wood trim at dormers; spot masonry repointing/repair; reline existing copper gutters.
