

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 23B of Chapter 39, as Amended, of the General Laws; and, with Section 20b of Chapter 30A of the General Laws, that the meeting of the Boston Redevelopment Authority will be held at 5:30 P.M. on Thursday, December 19, 2013 at the Boston Redevelopment Authority in the Kate Simonian Room, Room 900, City Hall, One City Hall Square, in the City of Boston, Massachusetts.

PUBLIC NOTICE (Chapter 121A)

The Boston Redevelopment Authority ("BRA"), pursuant to Chapter 652 of the Acts of 1960, as amended ("Chapter 652") and Chapter 121A of the Massachusetts General Laws, as amended (together with Chapter 652, "Chapter 121A") and the Rules and Regulations Governing Chapter 121A Projects in the City of Boston, as adopted by the Authority on June 22, 1978, as amended (the "Regulations") hereby gives notice of a public hearing to be held on Thursday, December 19, 2013 at 5:45 P.M. in the BRA Board Room, Boston City Hall, 9th Floor, One City Hall Square, Boston, Massachusetts 02201, on the application submitted by Boston Garden Development Corp., having an address of 100 Legends Way, Boston, MA 02114 and Boston Properties Limited Partnership, having an address of 800 Boylston Street, 19th Floor, Boston, MA 02199 (together the "Applicant") to the BRA on September 3, 2013, which application was updated on October 22, 2013, and further updated on December 5, 2013, pertaining to the Boston Garden Project (collectively, the "121A Application"). The Boston Garden Project will entail the construction of a mixed-use, 1,870,000± square foot project on the site of the former Boston Garden located at 80 Causeway Street (the "Project Site"), and will include buildings to be used for office, retail, hotel and residential purposes, and an expansion of the North Station parking garage to provide an additional 800 parking spaces. The Project Site is bounded by Causeway Street to the south, the TD Garden to the north, the pedestrian connection from Causeway Street to the TD Garden and North Station to the west and Interstate 93 to the east. The Applicant requests issuance of a Report and Decision by the BRA approving the 121A Application. A copy of the 121A Application may be reviewed in the office of the Secretary of the BRA, Room 910, Boston City Hall, 9th Floor, Boston, MA 02201 between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday, except legal holidays. The Acts of 1960, Chapter 652, Section 13 as amended provides that a person aggrieved by the approval or disapproval of a project has thirty days within which to seek judicial review, after filing with the City Clerk of Boston of any BRA Report and Decision approved by the Mayor of Boston.
