The Boston City Council's Committee on Housing will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, September 16, 2014 at 10:30 AM**. The hearing will be held in the Iannella Chamber on the Fifth Floor of Boston City Hall. The subject of the hearing is three dockets:

Docket #1159, Message and order for the confirmation of Ms. Helen Y. Wong as a member of the Boston Housing Authority Monitoring Committee for a term expiring January 4, 2016.

Docket #1160, Message and order for the confirmation of Mr. Mark Fortune as a member of the Boston Housing Authority Monitoring Committee for a term expiring January 4, 2016.

Docket #1161, Message and order for the confirmation of Ms. Dianna Christmas as a member of the Boston Housing Authority Monitoring Committee for a term expiring January 4, 2016.

Docket #1225, Message and order authorizing the Department of Neighborhood Development to apply for, accept, and expend Federal Fiscal Year 2014 Continuum of Care of Twenty Four Million Dollars (\$24,000,000.00) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to support programs that provide services and housing to the homeless.

All four dockets were sponsored by Mayor Martin J. Walsh. Dockets #1159-1161 were referred to the Committee on Housing on July 9, 2014 and Docket #1225 was referred to the Committee on Housing on July 30, 2014.

If you have not previously testified at a hearing of the Boston City Council, please arrive five (5) minutes before the call of the hearing to sign in and become familiar with the hearing format, testimony locations, and sound system.
