


THE PROJECT:

This renovation was one of seven projects funded by the nation's first youth participatory budgeting process, Youth Lead the Change. Young people between the ages of 12-15 brainstormed and developed projects across the city, and held a city-wide youth vote to allocate \$1M in capital funds.

Boston Parks and Recreation Department will be working with Youth Lead the Change and the broader community to re-design this playground.

WE NEED YOUR HELP!

The Parks Department is very interested in what the community and youth of the city have to contribute to the design process. The current project will focus on the area surrounding the current playground and picnic grove. We need your help in determining how this playground will look and function in the future

WHAT TO EXPECT:

At the first meeting, a synopsis of recent design process will be given, a site analysis will be presented and a list of desirable features will be developed.

Representatives from CBA Landscape Architects, as well as a Parks Department official, will be on hand to give a presentation of the project scope and existing site conditions. Representatives from Youth Lead the Change will be on hand to give a brief presentation on this exciting program. Following these presentations, community members, including youth and children, will be able to offer input regarding the material presented, the program for the park, and the design process.
