Said text amendment would amend Article 25 (Flood Hazard Districts) to adopt the current Flood Insurance Study report and Flood Insurance Rate Maps that resulted from the re-evaluation of coastal flood hazards in the City of Boston by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
