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COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

The Boston City Council's **Committee on Ways & Means** will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, April 28, 2016 at 12:00PM** in the Iannella Chamber, Fifth Floor, Boston City Hall.

The subjects of the hearing are:

- 0558** Message and order authorizing the Boston Police Department Licensing Division to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 for the purpose of purchasing, leasing, or renting space, materials and equipment, and to be partially or wholly used for instructional purposes for new hackney carriage drivers applicants and providing funds for other training needs not otherwise budgeted for.
- 0559** Message and order authorizing the Boston Police Department Special Operations Division to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to support the Canine Unit's training programs for officers and police dogs from non-City of Boston law enforcement agencies. The Special Operation Division will charge tuition and other fees to outside law enforcement agencies for training with Canine Unit.
- 0560** Message and order authorizing the Boston Police Academy to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to support training programs for officers from non-City of Boston law enforcement agencies. The Academy will charge participated outside law enforcement agencies tuition for each recruit, police officer or special police officer they send to the Academy.
- 0561** Message and order authorizing the Boston Police Department to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to pay salaries and benefits of employees and to purchase supplies and equipment necessary to operate the Police Department Fitness Center.

These matters were sponsored by **Mayor Martin J. Walsh** and were referred to the Committee on **April 13, 2016**.

If you have not testified at a Council hearing before, please arrive (5) minutes before the call of the hearing to sign up and become familiar with the hearing format, testimony locations, and sound system. Please bring fifteen (15) copies of any written documentation you wish to present at the hearing.
