COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

April 13, 2016

The Boston City Council's **Committee on Ways & Means** will hold a public hearing on **Monday, April 25, 2016 at 12:00PM** in the Iannella Chamber, Fifth Floor, Boston City Hall. The subject of the hearing is:

- 0544 Message and order authorizing the Mayor's Office of Arts and Culture to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to purchase goods and services to support public art throughout the City of Boston.
- 0545 Message and order authorizing the Mayor's Office of Arts and Culture to establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to purchase goods and services to support the operation of the Strand Theatre.
- 0546 Message and order authorizing the Mayor's Office of Tourism to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 for the purposes of purchasing goods and services to advance tourism and promote participation in public celebrations.
- 0547 Message and order authorizing the Law Department to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017, for the purposes of purchasing goods and services to pay for repairs to city property.
- 0550 Message and order authorizing the Office of Environmental and Energy Services to re-establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) to fund Fiscal Year 2017 to purchase offsets of greenhouse gas emissions which shall be associated with a portion of the electricity consumed by the City annually, thereby "greening" a greater percentage of the City's aggregate electricity load.

These matters were sponsored by **Mayor Martin J. Walsh** and were referred to the Committee on **April 13, 2016**.

Members of the public are cordially invited to attend and testify. If you have not testified at a Council hearing before, please arrive (5) minutes before the call of the hearing to sign up and become familiar with the hearing format, testimony locations, and sound system. Please bring fifteen (15) copies of any written documentation you wish to present at the hearing.
