The Boston City Council's **Committee on City and Neighborhood Services**, to which was referred the following:

Docket #0140 - Petition of Boston Metro Shuttle, for a license to operate motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire over certain streets in Boston.

- Finding that Committee held a hearing on this matter.
- Finding that the petitioner did not have all the required documentation and other relevant information to present at the hearing.
- Finding that at the request of the petitioner and with the agreement of the officials representing the Boston Police and Transportation Departments, the Chair granted an additional thirty days for submittal of the required information and documents.
- Finding that the petitioner has not submitted the required substantiation for this petition.

Having considered the same I respectfully recommend that the ***petition ought to be denied without prejudice.***

Seating capacity: 14 passengers, including driver


Other remarks: these vehicles are emission free (Green)

4. Bank of America Pavilion: service shuttle from parking lots during concerts
5. Tall Ships service shuttle from parking lots during event
6. "Event Sensitive": provide services as requested
