
TO THE CITY COUNCIL

**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND
EXPEND A FISCAL YEAR 2007 PORT SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT FROM
THE MASSACHUSETTS EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND
SECURITY**

ORDERED: That, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A, the City of Boston, acting by and through its Fire Department, be, and hereby is, authorized to accept a Port Security Program Grant in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Nineteen Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Three Dollars and No Cents (\$819,743.00) from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security, to expend said funds for the construction of a Chemical, Biological Radiological and Nuclear Explosive (CBRNE) Watercraft, and to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
