TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I submit herewith and request your approval of an Order confirming the appointment of William F. Sinnott, Corporation Counsel of the City of Boston, as the City's liaison to the State Ethics Commission as required by Chapter 28 of the Acts of 2009, the Ethics Reform Act.

Section 29 was added to Chapter 268A by the Ethics Reform Act. This requires every city and town in the Commonwealth, acting through its city council, board of selectmen or board of alderman, to designate a senior level employee as liaison to the State Ethics Commission.

Mr. Sinnott has spearheaded the effort to train all city employees on their responsibilities under Chapter 268A and is working closely with the Office of Human Resources to ensure that all requirements mandated by the Ethics Reform Act are met. His office is operating as the current conduit to the State Ethics Commission, and has a good working relationship with the Commission.

I respectfully recommend the adoption of this Order by your Honorable Body


