Dear Councillors:

The Committee on Government Operations held a hearing to discuss an order authorizing the City of Boston to extend a contract with Infor Global Solutions, now Hansen Information Technologies, Inc., for a term not to exceed four (4) years for the implementation of a permitting and licensing software application in ISD. This matter was sponsored by Mayor Menino, referred to this Committee on Wednesday, March 4, 2009, and heard at a public hearing on Monday, March 23, 2009 at which public comment was taken.

The proposed order would authorize the City to continue an existing contract to complete a permitting and licensing software project used for the Inspectional Services Department. At the hearing representatives from the City's Management Information Systems Department testified in support of the authorization. OIS Director Oates testified that the existing contract has run past its three-year term period. According to OIS the project has made great progress, but was stalled because of Hansen's acquisition of the previous contracting company, Infor Global Solutions.

OIS representatives testified that after the acquisition and discussion with Hansen over the terms of the existing contract, they are confident that this extension will allow them to finish the contract's purpose. OIS also clarified that the contract was a fixed price contract based on variables and should not lead to extra costs for the City outside the original RFP parameters. This authorization will allow the City to complete its on-going initiative to streamline ISD processes.

By the Chair of the Committee on Government Operations, to which the following was referred:

Docket #0358 an order authorizing the City of Boston to extend a contract with Infor Global Solutions, now Hansen Information Technologies, Inc., for a term not to exceed four (4) years for the implementation of a permitting and licensing software application in ISD.

based on information presented at the hearing and public comment gathered by the Committee and having considered the same, respectfully recommends that this matter ought to pass.


