0110 Order declare surplus City owned former Real Estate-Owned (REO) property known as 5 Dewey Street, Dorchester, to transfer care, custody, management and control of said property to the Public Facilities Commission.

0133 Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept from the Trustees of the Boston Public Library certain real property known as the Charlestown Service Building located at 374-398 Bunker Hill Street, Charlestown, and the care, custody, management and control thereof is hereby transferred to the Public Facilities Commission.


