**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE BOSTON PARKS
AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT
TO UTILIZE FUNDS FROM THE GEORGE FRANCIS PARKMAN FUND**

ORDERED: That the sum of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the income of the George Francis Parkman Fund to be expended at the direction of the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation as follows:

For the general care and maintenance of the Boston
Common and Parks in existence as of January 12, 1887..... \$800,000.00

For the specialized maintenance of the horticulture and
infrastructure of the Boston Common and Parks in
existence as of January 12, 1887 \$185,000.00

For equipment, infrastructure improvements and repairs
in the Boston Common and Parks in existence as of
January 12, 1887..... \$15,000.00
