I transmit herewith for your approval an appropriation order in the amount of \$20,705,000 for the original construction of public ways or the extension or widening thereof, including land damages and the cost of pavement and sidewalks laid at the time of said construction, or for the construction of stone, block, brick, cement concrete, bituminous concrete, bituminous macadam or other permanent pavement of similar lasting character, and/or for the construction of sidewalks of brick, bituminous concrete, stone or concrete, and/or for the construction of walls or dikes for the protection of highways or property, and/or for traffic signal, or public lighting installations, and for the purpose of extending and improving such installations, and/or for the cost of engineering or architectural services for plans and specifications for the purposes of city departments including the Public Works and Transportation Departments.

I urge your Honorable Body to pass this order.

ORDERED: That the sum of Twenty Million Seven Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$20,705,000) be, and hereby is, appropriated for the original construction of public ways or the extension or widening thereof, including land damages and the cost of pavement and sidewalks laid at the time of said construction, or for the construction of stone, block, brick, cement concrete, bituminous concrete, bituminous macadam or other permanent pavement of similar lasting character, and/or for the construction of sidewalks of brick, bituminous concrete, stone or concrete, and/or for the construction of walls or dikes for the protection of highways or property, and/or for traffic signal, or public lighting installations, and for the purpose of extending and improving such installations, and/or for the cost of engineering or architectural services for plans and specifications for the purposes of city departments including the Public Works and Transportation Departments; and that to meet said appropriation the Collector/Treasurer be, and hereby is, authorized under the provisions of Clauses (5), (6), (7), (14) and/or (22) of Section 7 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws, or any other enabling authority, to issue from time to time, with the approval of the Mayor, bonds, notes or certificates of indebtedness of the City up to said amount, provided that the appropriation authorized through this order be expended only on those project(s) as described by name attached hereto; that this order shall constitute a declaration of official intent of the City pursuant to Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2(e) to reimburse expenditures for such projects made from funds established for such purpose as permitted by statute from proceeds of debt incurred by the City pursuant to this order; and that pursuant to Section 12(b) of Chapter 643 of the Acts of 1983 as amended, if any part of the proceeds of sale of any bonds or notes or other obligations issued by the City under this order remains unexpended after the work or purpose for which such bonds, notes or other obligations are issued is completed, such proceeds are hereby appropriated and may be applied by the Collector-Treasurer and City Auditor, at the direction of the Mayor, to pay the principal, premium or interest on such bonds, notes or other obligations or on any other debt of the City.
