WHEREAS, the Boston Redevelopment Authority has acquired a vacant Real Estate Owned (REO) Property at the Request of the City of Boston; and

WHEREAS, the Public Facilities Commission has voted to accept this property; and

WHEREAS, the Boston Redevelopment Authority has transferred said property at cost to the City of Boston acting by and through its Public Facilities Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Public Facilities Commission acting by the Department of Neighborhood Development has determined that the property is not needed by the Department, it is hereby

ORDERED: that the property located at **59 Spencer Street**, Dorchester (Ward 17, Parcel 00228000) is hereby found to be surplus within the meaning of St. 1909, c. 486 § 31B (as appearing in St. 1966, c. 642 § 12) and the care, custody, management and control thereof is hereby transferred to the Public Facilities Commission.
