Councilors:

In accordance with Chapter 6 of the Ordinances of 1979, I hereby notify you of the following actions taken by the Mayor with regard to the papers acted upon by the City Council at its meeting of March 11, 2009 viz.

0135 Order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of \$13,026,800.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS), to address the unique equipment, planning, exercise, training and operational needs of large urban areas.
Approved by the Mayor March 19, 2009.

0136 Order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of \$3,500,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS), to support coordination of regional all-hazard planning for catastrophic events, including the development of integrated planning communities, plans protocols, and procedures.

0137 Order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of \$120,000.00 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program, to build community readiness and preparedness for a disaster, empowering citizens to make their communities safer.
