

**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT,
AND EXPEND FEDERAL FY2009 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT FUNDS AND FEDERAL FY2008 AMERICAN RECOVERY AND
REINVESTMENT ACT (STIMULUS BILL) FUNDS FROM THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)**

- WHEREAS,** the United States Code, as amended, contains provisions authorizing the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to make grants to units of general local government in accordance with Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.), Title IV, Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 1137 et seq.), Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12701 et seq.), and the AIDS Housing Opportunity Act (42 U.S.C. 12901 et seq.), Title XII of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Boston is eligible to apply for and receive various Federal Fiscal Year 2009 Housing and Community Development Funds and Federal Fiscal Year 2008 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
- WHEREAS,** the Department of Neighborhood Development will administer the Federal FY2009 Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Shelter Grant, Home Investment Partnership Program, Housing Opportunity for Persons with AIDS, Section 108 Loan Guarantee, Community Development Block Grant – Recovery, Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program funds; now, therefore, be it
- ORDERED,** that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Federal FY2009 Community Development Block Grant funds in an amount not to exceed Twenty Million Forty One Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty Three Dollars (\$20,041,353.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Action Plan, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further, be it

- ORDERED,** that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Federal FY2009 Emergency Shelter Grant funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand and Fifty Two Dollars (\$880,052.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Action Plan, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further, be it
- ORDERED,** that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development FY2009 HOME Investment Partnerships Program Grant funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Million Five Hundred and Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Nine Dollars (\$8,509,809.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Action Plan, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further be it
- ORDERED,** that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Federal FY2009 Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS Grant funds in an amount not to exceed One Million Eight Hundred Three Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty Eight Dollars (\$1,803,368.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which they are granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Action Plan, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further be it
- ORDERED,** that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Section 108 Loan Guarantee funds in an amount not to exceed Thirty One Million Dollars (\$31,000,000.00); and is further authorized to make any such pledge of Community Development Block Grant funds as HUD may require pursuant to 24 CFR Part 570.705(b)(2); and to expend said Section 108 Loan Guarantee funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which they are granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Action Plan, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further be it

ORDERED, that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Federal FY2008 Community Development Block Grant Recovery funds in an amount not to exceed Five Million Three Hundred Sixty Six Thousand and Eleven Dollars (\$5,366,011.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which they are granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2008 Community Development Block Grant Recovery Substantial Amendment, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; further be it

ORDERED, that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be and hereby is, authorized to apply for and accept from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Federal FY2008 Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Million Two Hundred Nine Thousand One Hundred and Fifty One Dollars (\$8,209,151.00); and to expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which they are granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2008 Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program Substantial Amendment, and in connection therewith, to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
