




RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL PRESIDENT MICHAEL ROSS &

- WHEREAS:** This is Boston University's 5th national championship, with a season record of 35-6-4, setting the single-season school record for wins; **and**
- WHEREAS:** This was their 21st appearance in the national semifinals, 31st NCAA tournament appearance, 14th conference title, including 7th Hockey East title, and their 29th Beanpot title; **and**
- WHEREAS:** This year the BU hockey team won the Ice Breaker, the Denver Cup, the Beanpot, Hockey East regular season, Hockey East tournament, NCAA Northeast Regional and NCAA championships; **and**
- WHEREAS:** Senior defenseman Matt Gilroy was named the 2009 Hobey Baker Memorial Award winner and the 57th Walter Brown Award winner, recognizing the best American-born college hockey player in New England; **and**
- WHEREAS:** Coach Jack Parker, a BU legend, in his 36th season as BU's head coach, won his 800th game, where he has led BU to 23 NCAA tournaments and 30 NCAA tournament wins, both totals are more than any other college hockey coach, he has won 3 national championships as head coach (1978, 1995, 2009), and was named National Coach of the Year; **Therefore be it**
- RESOLVED:** That the Boston City Council hereby extends its congratulations to the Boston University hockey team for winning the National Championship
