**ORDER DECLARING THE LAND AND BUILDING ACQUIRED BY THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR LIBRARY PURPOSES AS SURPLUS AND TRANSFERRING CARE, CUSTODY, MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE PUBLIC FACILITIES COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Boston acquired the land and building at 5 Crawford Street, also known as 621 Warren Street, Dorchester, MA (Ward 12, Parcel 02570 000), for library purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Boston Public Library has determined that the property is not needed; and

**WHEREAS,** the Public Facilities Commission has voted to accept this property; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Boston Public Facilities Department/Department of Neighborhood Development has determined that the property is not needed by the Department, it is hereby

**ORDERED:** that the property located at 5 Crawford Street, also known as 621 Warren Street, Dorchester, MA (Ward 12, Parcel 02570 000), is hereby found to be surplus within the meaning of St. 1909, c. 486, § 31B (as appearing in St. 1966, c. 642, § 12) and the care, custody, management and control thereof is hereby transferred to the Public Facilities Commission.
