WHEREAS, the City of Boston acquired the land and building at 5 Crawford Street, also known as 621 Warren Street, Dorchester, MA (Ward 12, Parcel 02570 000), for library purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boston Public Library has determined that the property is not needed; and

WHEREAS, the Public Facilities Commission has voted to accept this property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boston Public Facilities Department/Department of Neighborhood Development has determined that the property is not needed by the Department, it is hereby

ORDERED: that the property located at 5 Crawford Street, also known as 621 Warren Street, Dorchester, MA (Ward 12, Parcel 02570 000), is hereby found to be surplus within the meaning of St. 1909, c. 486, § 31B (as appearing in St. 1966, c. 642, § 12) and the care, custody, management and control thereof is hereby transferred to the Public Facilities Commission.
