**Re: Neponset River Bridge – Street Lights**

*Dear Ms. Jones:*

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 164, § 1B(a), NSTAR Electric Company (NSTAR) hereby provides its consent to National Grid to provide distribution service to the Department of Conservation and Recreation's (DCR) proposed street lights located on the Dorchester side of the Neponset River Bridge, adjacent to and bordering Quincy, Massachusetts.

NSTAR's consent is based on the fact that DCR plans to reconstruct the Neponset River Bridge and will be replacing the entire existing un-metered street lighting system (presently served by both NSTAR and National Grid) with a new system, including poles, fixtures, conduit and electrical service purchased, installed and maintained by DCR and the meter location for the new system is located in Quincy, Massachusetts.

NSTAR's consent is strictly limited to the street lights that are located on the bridge structure itself and does not include consent for distribution service for any other DCR streetlights located adjacent to the Neponset Bridge in the Dorchester section of Boston.
