TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith a supplemental appropriation order for the School Department for FY10 in the amount of \$722,533 to cover the FY10 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the Boston School Committee and the Painters and Allied Trades, District Council No. 35, Local 1952 (Custodians). The term of the contract is September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010. The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2.75% effective September 1, 2008 and 2.5% effective August 31, 2010, as well as changes to health insurance contributions in fiscal year 2009.

As originally presented to you, the FY10 budget request included a Reserve for Collective Bargaining - a separate appropriation to fund projected collective bargaining increases. A separate order has been filed to reduce that appropriation to support this supplemental request. The FY09 cost items will be charged to the collective bargaining reserve established for that year.

I respectfully request your support of this supplemental appropriation.
