To The City Council

Councilors:

In accordance with Chapter 6 of the Ordinances of 1979, I hereby notify you of the following actions taken by the Mayor with regard to the papers acted upon by the City Council at its meeting of June 24, 2009 viz.

0390 Order authorizing the Office of Arts, Tourism and Special Events to accept and expend a grant of \$176,100.00 from the Massachusetts Cultural Council, to support year-round programming agendas of Boston's Cultural and Educational Organizations.

Approved by the Mayor June 25, 2009.

0497 Order for a loan of \$10,985,000.00 for the remodeling, reconstructing, or making extraordinary repairs to public buildings owned by the City, including original equipment and landscaping, paving and other site improvements incidental or directly related to such remodeling, reconstruction or repair for the purposes of the School Department.

Approved by the Mayor June 29, 2009.

0498 Order for a loan of \$4,440,000.00 for remodeling, reconstructing, or making extraordinary repairs to public buildings owned by the City, including original equipment and landscaping, paving and other site improvements incidental or directly related to such remodeling, reconstruction or repair for the acquisition of departmental equipment, and/or for the cost of engineering or architectural services for plans and specifications for the purposes of the City departments including the Boston Center for Youth and Families, Library, Property and Construction Management and Public Health Commission Departments.
Approved by the Mayor June 29, 2009.

0499 Order for a loan of \$1,845,000.00 for the construction of municipal outdoor recreational and athletic facilities, including the acquisition and development of land and the construction and reconstruction of such facilities, for the cost engineering of architectural services for plans and specifications, and/or for the acquisition of departmental equipment for the purposes of city departments including the Parks and Recreation and School Departments.
Approved by the Mayor June 29, 2009.

0500 Order for a loan of \$3,385,000.00 for the acquisition of departmental equipment, for the purposes of the Fire Department.
Approved by the Mayor June 29, 2009.

0501 Order for a loan of \$12,120,000.00 for the original construction of public ways of the extension or widening thereof, including land damages and the cost of pavement and sidewalks laid at the time of said construction, or for the construction of stone, block, brick, cement concrete, bituminous concrete, bituminous macadam or other permanent pavement of similar lasting character, for the construction of sidewalks of brick, bituminous concrete, stone or concrete, and/or for traffic signal, or public lighting installations, and for the purpose of extending and improving such installations, for the purposes of city departments including the Public Works Department.
Approved by the Mayor June 29, 2009.

0502 Order for a loan of \$15,655,000.00 for the development, design, purchase, installation and operation of computer hardware, computer software, other data processing equipment and computer assisted integrated financial management and accounting systems, for the acquisition of departmental equipment, for fire alarm or police communication installations and for the purpose of extending and improving such installations, and/or for remodeling, reconstructing, or making extraordinary repairs to public buildings owned by the City including original equipment and landscaping, paving and other site improvements incidental or directly related to such remodeling, reconstruction or repair, for the purposes of city departments including the Management Information Services Department.

0503 Order for a loan of \$305,000.00 for the purposes of planting shade trees, planning, designing, acquiring land for, constructing and originally equipping structures and facilities it is authorized to construct, and for remodeling, reconstructing, or making major alterations, additions and repairs to the existing facilities including original equipment and landscaping, paving and other site improvements incidental or directly related to such remodeling, reconstruction or repair, for the purposes of the Parks and Recreation Department.

0504 Order authorizing the City to enter into one or more lease, lease-purchase or installment sales agreements in FY2010 in an amount not to exceed \$8,800,000.00 and in FY2011 in an amount not to exceed \$10,560,000.00 for various City departments for the acquisition of equipment in furtherance of their respective governmental functions.
