

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS FROM VARIOUS GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, INCLUDING FEMA, AS REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES INCURRED RELATED TO SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING FROM MARCH 12, 2010-APRIL 26, 2010.

ORDERED: That the City of Boston be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend an amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,400,000 00) from various government agencies, including FEMA, as reimbursement for expenses incurred related to severe storms and flooding from March 12, 2010-April 26, 2010.
