Councilors:

In accordance with Chapter 6 of the Ordinances of 1979, I hereby notify you of the following actions taken by the Mayor with regard to the papers acted upon by the City Council at its meeting of June 9, 2010 viz.

0738 Order that in addition to the appropriations heretofore made, and subject to ratification by Local 718 IAFF of a collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2010 through June 30 2011, to meet the current operating expenses of the fiscal period commencing July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010 the sum of \$20,481,530 be, and the same hereby is appropriated as follows, said sum to be met from available funds pursuant to Section 23 of Chapter 59 of the General laws.

0739 Order to reduce the FY10 appropriation for the Reserve for Collective Bargaining by \$16,102,528.00 to provide funding in the Fire Department for the FY10 cost items contained in the arbitration award of JLMC Case No. 08-02F on May 3, 2010 which amends the salary schedule for local 718, International Association of Firefighters.


