The Vietnamese American Community of Massachusetts

In Recognition of:

Those persons who are part of the Catholic community of Tam Toa in Vietnam, who have stood up to fight for their right to religious freedom. Though Catholics have always been the minority in Vietnam, recently the tensions between the Catholic community and the Communist Government of Vietnam have erupted, and resulted in violence. Most notably, two priests were beat by a band of "roaming thugs" for participating in a demonstration of prayer and protest. In light of these events, the Vietnamese American Community of Massachusetts is hosting a demonstration to fight for religious freedom in Vietnam. Therefore be it resolved that the Boston City Council, in meeting assembled, does hereby extend its congratulations to the Vietnamese American Community of Massachusetts for acknowledging these events and does extend its continuing support for religious freedom throughout the world; and that this resolution be duly signed by the President of the City Council and attested to and a copy thereof transmitted by the Clerk of the City of Boston.
