Dear Councillors:

The Boston City Council's Committee on Public Safety to which was referred, on September 16, 2009 and September 30, 2009 [respectively]:

***Docket # 1175*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$949,599.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, for the purpose of supporting crime prevention and law enforcement.

***Docket # 1177*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$113,030.00 from the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security, for the purpose of funding the Boston Police Department's FY08 Buffer Zone Project.

***Docket # 1178*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$11,600.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Violence Against Women, for training for law enforcement and improved services for response to violence and abuse of woman later in life.

***Docket # 1220*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$500,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance funded under FY09 Smart Policing: Evidence Based Law Enforcement grant program.

***Docket # 1222*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$125,000.00 from the FY09 Paul Coverdell National Forensic Science Improvement Act Formula funded by the National Institute of Justice.

***Docket # 1225*** – Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend the FY08 VAWA STOP grant of \$38,160.00 from the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security to support the BPD's Civilian Domestic Violence Advocate.



**ORDERED:** That the Police Commissioner, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the award of the US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant, for the purposes of supporting crime prevention and law enforcement, not to exceed the amount of Nine Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$949,599.00).
