

MASSACHUSETTS TECHNOLOGY COLLABORATIVE REBATE FUNDS FOR
SOLAR ENERGY INSTALLATIONS AT
BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

ORDERED: That the Environmental and Energy Services Chief, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the award of the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MTC) rebates to fund solar photovoltaic installations on the Boston Latin Academy, Boston Latin School and the Franklin D. Roosevelt School. Two hundred thirty-five thousand and ninety nine dollars (\$235,099.00) from the MTC's Clean Energy Choice-Low Income program will be used for a solar electric installation on the Boston Latin Academy and eighty-one thousand six hundred seven dollars and forty-seven cents (\$81,607.47) from MTC's Clean Energy Choice program will fund installations at the Boston Latin Academy, the Boston Latin School and the Franklin D. Roosevelt School.
