
WHEREAS, the United States Code, as amended, contains provisions authorizing the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to make grants to units of general local government under Title IV, Subtitle F of the Stewart B. McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11403-11407b); and

WHEREAS, the City of Boston is eligible to apply for Federal Fiscal Year 2009 Shelter Plus Care Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Neighborhood Development will administer the Federal FY2009 Community Shelter Plus Care grants; now, therefore, be it

ORDERED, that the City of Boston, acting by and through its Department of Neighborhood Development, be, and hereby is, authorized to apply for FY2009 Shelter Plus Care grant funds in an amount not to exceed Seven Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,200,000.00) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, to accept and expend said funds in accordance with M.G.L. c. 44, § 53A for the purposes for which the funds were granted as stated in the City of Boston's Federal FY2009 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Programs application, and, in connection therewith, is further authorized to execute and deliver such documents as may be required by the federal government.
