RESOLUTION REQUESTING A MEMORIAL (HERO) SQUARE AT THE JUNCTION OF HEMMAN AND KITTREDGE STREETS TO HONOR NIKOLAUS ZOZULA

- WHEREAS*, Nikolaus Zozula was a resident of Hemman Street in Roslindale; and,
- WHEREAS*, He enlisted in the United States Army in September, 1968; and,
- WHEREAS*, While serving his country, he was killed in action in Vietnam on November 2nd, 1969; and,
- WHEREAS*, Honoring his sacrifice and in recognition of his dedicated performance to his nation, it is fitting that the memory of this gallant warrior be honored in appropriate fashion; *THEREFORE BE IT*
- RESOLVED*, By the Boston City Council and the Veterans Services Department be requested to coordinate the placement of a Memorial (Hero) Square at the junction of Hemman and Kittredge Streets, close to where he lived, in honor of his valiant service to his country.
