The Boston City Council's Committee on City, Neighborhood Services and Veteran Affairs to which was referred the following:

Docket #1080 – Message and order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of \$300,000.00 from the DOE, Recover Act LEAP to strengthen and expand local Govt. energy assurance planning and resiliency, reduce impacts from energy supply disruptions & create & save jobs in energy assurance planning.

Docket #1392 – Message and order authorizing the Public Works Dept. to accept and expend a grant of \$300,000.00 from the Dept. of Energy, for the purpose of Solar Compact Energy Efficiency Research Demonstration Project.

Docket #1393 – Message and order authorizing the Public Works Dept., Waste Reduction Div. to accept and expend a grant of \$85,380.00 from the Mass. Dept. of Conservation & Recreation, to pay the yard waste collection and processing in the Asian Longhorned Beetle Regulated Area surrounding the J.P. area of Boston.





**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO EXPEND FUNDS
FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE
COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF YARD WASTE**

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the City of Boston Public Works Department, Waste Reduction Division, to pay for yard waste collection and processing in the Asian Longhorned Beetle Regulated Area surrounding the Jamaica Plain section of Boston; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of \$85,380.00 will be utilized by the City of Boston to fund yard waste collection and processing in the regulated area to suppress and control the Asian Longhorned Beetle for a 12 week period, it is hereby

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is, authorized to accept and expend, upon receipt from the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation, funds not to exceed the amount of \$85,380.00.
