

- WHEREAS: Gladtidings House of Prayer for All Nations also offers the Henrietta Scholarship Fund for high school graduates to further their education; and
- WHEREAS: Gladtidings House of Prayer for All Nations, in 2002, extended its ministry to Florida, establishing a brand new church at 4545 Pleasant Hill Road in Poinciana, Florida; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Hezron Farrell and First Lady Dr. Gwendolyn Farrell have evangelized throughout the world, spreading the word of God in South Africa, Israel, Thailand, England, St. Kitts, Nevis, St. Thomas, Ohio, New York, and many others; and
- WHEREAS: Gladtidings House of Prayer for All Nations, under direction of the Holy Spirit, has established over 34 ministries in its local church; Be It Therefore
