ORDINANCES TO INCREASE FEES FOR LIGHTING OF PARKS AND RECREATION PLAYING FIELDS

City of Boston Code, Ordinances, Chapter XVIII, Section 1 16, is hereby amended by striking out from paragraph 25 the words "in the case of users who are not residents of the City of Boston, the fee for such use of a lighted playing field shall be fifty (\$50.00) dollars per hour" and inserting in place thereof the words "in the case of users who are not residents of the City of Boston, the fee for such use of a lighted playing field shall be one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per hour"
