The Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on Education held a joint hearing on **December 2, 2010** in order to discuss:

Docket #1540 - Message and order authorizing the City to accept a grant of Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000.00) from the Boston Redevelopment Authority, for the purpose of designing, constructing, renovating and equipping the Quincy Upper School

And;

Docket #1541 - Message and order approving an appropriation of \$550,000.00 for the feasibility study for major rehabilitation of the Quincy Upper School. The statement of interest for the Quincy Upper School, which was approved by the City Council on June 27, 2007, has been accepted by the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA).
