The Boston City Council's Committee on Public Safety to which was referred on October 27, 2010 and November 17, 2010:

Docket # 1479 - Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$96,250.00 from the Mass Dept. of Mental Health under the FY 2011-FY2012 Jail Diversion Program Grant.

Docket # 1545 - Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of One Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety's Senator Charles E. Shannon, Jr. Community Safety Initiative Grant, for the purpose of supporting strategies to address youth, gang and gun violence.

Docket # 1549 - Message and order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend the FY 2011 Funds to Increase Crash Reporting to Enhance Highway Safety Planning and Programming grant of \$287,500.00 from the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security used to identify a sustainable, cost-effective process for transmitting crash reports to the Registry of Motor Vehicles in a timely fashion.

Docket # 1550 - Message and order authorizing the Mayor to accept and expend the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Federal FY 2007 Citizen Corp Program grant of \$13,800.00 to coordinate the involvement of community members and organizations in emergency preparedness, planning, mitigation, response and recovery.

Docket # 1551 - Message and order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of \$16,200.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Citizen Corps Program (CCP) to coordinate the involvement of community members and organizations in emergency preparedness, planning, mitigation, response and recovery.

Citizen Corps Program (CCO) FFY 2008

The Mayor's Office of Emergency Management will utilize FFY 2008 Citizen Corps Program (CCP) funding to enhance and expand advertising and outreach efforts for the Boston Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program, upgrade and enhance CERT equipment, and outfit emergency shelter trailer investments and response capabilities.

OEM will procure additional equipment for shelter operations trailers, to include: generators, lighting, and shelter management systems, and items to support animal care, and radio communications equipment for CERT members.
