Councilors:

In accordance with Chapter 6 of the Ordinances of 1979, I hereby notify you of the following actions taken by the Mayor with regard to the papers acted upon by the City Council at its meeting of October 20, 2010 viz.

0592 Order authorizing the Mayor's Office of Emergency Management to accept and expend a grant of \$400,000.00 from the Federal Government under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, for the purpose of Assurance Planning for the Mayor's Office of Emergency Management.

Approved by the Mayor October 25, 2010

1076 Order authorizing the Mayor's Office of Emergency Management to accept and expend a grant of Eleven Million Six Hundred Fifty One Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollar (\$11,651,680.00) from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS), Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant FY2009, to address the unique planning, training, exercise, equipment, and operational needs of large urban areas.

1078 Order authorizing the City to accept and expend a grant of One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,400,000.00) from various Government Agencies, including FEMA, as reimbursement for expenses incurred due to server storms and flooding that occurred in March and April 2010.



- 1081 Order authorizing the Fire Academy to establish in accordance with General Law Chapter 44, Section 53E ½ a revolving fund to accept from the fund up to a maximum of \$200,000.00 for the purpose of purchasing training equipment, certifying instructors, updating facilities, and providing funds for other training needs not otherwise budgeted for.

- 1145 Order authorizing the Fire Department to accept and expend a Port Security Program Grant of One Million, One Hundred Eighty Thousand, Two hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$1,180,257.00) from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security, for the construction of a Chemical, Biological Radiological and Nuclear Explosive (CBRNE) Watercraft.

- 1146 Order authorizing the Public Health Commission to accept and expend a grant of \$750,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs FY 2009 Discretionary Grant Program, for the purpose of violence intervention and prevention in the City.

- 1147 Order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend \$300,000.00 of the FY2010 ICAC Program award, from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, to indentify child victims of commercial sexual exploitation, provide services and support for them, and investigate and prosecute cases against adults who exploit children and youth.

- 1225 Order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend a grant of \$307,967.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, for the FY 2010 Forensic DNA Backlog Reduction Program.

- 1226 Order authorizing the Police Commissioner to accept and expend the FY10 (VAWA) STOP grant of \$43,560.00, from the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security to support the BPD's Civilian Domestic Violence Advocate.

- 1296 Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend a grant of \$112,750.00 over two years starting in FY2011 awarded by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and passed through the Boston Public Health Commission to support Boston Transportation Department Community Bike Programs.

- 1297 Order to declare surplus a portion of 221-227 Commercial Street, Boston, approximately 561+ sq. ft., which is currently owned by the City of Boston, shown on plan entitled "City of Boston, Public Works Department, Engineering Division, Discontinuance Plan, 221-227 Commercial Street, Boston to convey the proposed area by a Release Deed in form satisfactory to the Corporation Counsel.

- 1350 Order authorizing the Mayor to accept and expend a grant of Four Million Three Hundred and Twelve Thousand Four Hundred and Seventy Six Dollars (\$4,312,476.00) from National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), to provide three in-depth programs (Technology Goes Home, On Line Learning Readiness, and Connected Living) which will use high-speed internet broadband access to provide training on how the internet can improve lives and enhance job prospects.
