In the interest of productively moving forward in the development of the standards and criteria for the pending FPCLD, and being able to give full consideration to public comments on sections of the standards and criteria as they are being developed, the Fort Point Channel Study Committee requests that any written comments on the standards and criteria scheduled to be discussed at this meeting be submitted to Boston Landmarks Commission staff no later than the Monday preceding the meeting by 12 noon, or the Friday preceding the meeting by 3pm when Monday is a holiday. Presentation of additional comments may also be made verbally to the Committee at this meeting. If the Committee's discussion on a section of the standards and criteria extends beyond a single meeting, comments on any new or revised language will be considered at the next meeting. Once the Committee has voted to accept a particular section of the standards and criteria, further comments on those sections will not be addressed until a future meeting after all of the standards and criteria have been completed. At that time the Committee will make a final review of the entire document.
