RE: Clarification and Correct Contact

Dear Attorney Sinatra:

This letter is in response to your letter which was received on January 29, 2013. As a point of clarification, the Mayor of the City of Boston, Mayor Thomas M. Menino and his staff do not recall receiving multiple phone messages from Mr. Wynn, as your letter indicated. Nor does the Mayor or other City officials recall receiving meeting requests from Mr. Wynn. In fact, aside from one recent missed phone call in late January, your letter dated January 25, 2012, is the first known direct contact that City officials have had from Wynn Resorts seeking to discuss with the City of Boston the Company's interests in the Boston area.

Although it is not clear from your letter, we anticipate that your request for a phone call is in regards to a potential casino development in Massachusetts. If this is the case, may I suggest that your Company, like any other potential casino developer, should speak with me and Brian Leary, the Chairman of the Mayor's casino advisory committee. I would be pleased to arrange such a phone call.
